The Hydroplane and Raceboat Museum reached another important milestone this month by unveiling the brand new 'Video Vault'. For those who truly enjoy the history of hydroplane racing, the Video Vault is a dream come true. Here, contained in one on-line video venue, are the full-length, historic racing videos that either you missed, or you remember so fondly. Where the history of boat racing is concerned, there is no more thorough, complete, or amazing archive than the Video Vault. And it grows by the week.

Created as a resource for museum members, the Video Vault is an important new feature on the museum's web site, and it contains a treasure trove including hundreds of rare and unseen films. Museum members simply log-on to have unlimited access to the Video Vault, which includes races from the late 1940's to present day along with many special films featuring legendary boats and drivers.

The Video Vault already represents one of the largest archives of boat racing films in the world and the museum film staff will be adding new shows on a regular basis. To date, there are over 200 vaulted videos, a number that will likely double over the next year.

Many of the films are first generation or original copies, which the museum has acquired over the past 30 years. The videos stream to your computer at DVD or better quality. They range from original kinescopes, 8mm and 16mm film through 3/4", 1" and Betacam video. These include race broadcasts, special features, interviews, promo films and home movies. Many videos are presented uncut, in their original form.

The videos are grouped into four categories for easy access: "Races", "Boat & Driver Films and Documentaries", "Promotional Films" and "Limited, Outboards and R/C." The Video Vault invites viewer comments and questions about each film.

Access to the Hydroplane and Raceboat Museum Video Vault is absolutely free to current museum members who have joined at the \$100 or higher level per year. Members who have joined the museum at the minimum level of \$50 can upgrade to gain access to the Video Vault. To become a museum member, or to upgrade a current limited membership, just visit the museum website and follow the prompts. Once members opt in at the required level, they will be granted unlimited access to the vault.
